"... improve student safety, campus security, repair roofs, upgrade aging classrooms [in all 3 bond measures], attract/ retain qualified teachers; and fencing."

With this latest "temporary" parcel tax, Jefferson Elementary School District claims they need of more money to continue providing quality education.

- 2018-19: 52.21% of children failed to meet state standards.
